CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND RULES

1. Entries close on Friday, 1st. July and must be accompanied by correct entry fee.
2. "All entries are made to and accepted by the Bannow and Rathangan Show Society Company Limited."
3. Cheques, Postal Orders and all monies payable to Hon. Secretary.
4. All Exhibits to be presented by 10.00 a.m. Ring 6 by 9.30 a.m. - Horse Jumping Entries (see Schedule)
5. Rosettes, Cards and Badges of other Shows not allowed on any exhibit.
6. No second prize for less than three entries and no third prize for less than five entries, no fourth prize for less than seven entries in any class. No prizes for one entry.
7. All horses shown in Riding Classes shall not be shown in hand except in the case of special prizes.
8. Neither the Company, Committee or Landowners will be responsible for any loss, accident or damage to any exhibit while at the show or in transit to or therefore. All entries are accepted at Owners risk. No claim for compensation arising out of the Show will be entertained, neither will liability be accepted for any accident to any exhibitor, his or her servants or to any spectator present.
9. The Show Committee reserve the right to abandon or postpone the Show or cancel or alter any class.
10. No animal is eligible for entry in more than one Class except in the case of special prizes.
11. Exhibitors must satisfy themselves that their exhibits are in correct classes and bear correct number before judging commences.
12. All dogs must be on leads.
13. The decision of the Judges shall be final, and the instructions of stewards and officials must be obeyed at all times.
14. In the event of an appointed Judge not being available on day of show the committee reserves the right to appoint a Judge.
15. The winner of any Cup not won outright shall be responsible to the Secretary for its safe custody and for production and delivery to the Society in the same condition in which it was received not later than 1st April, 2012.
16. All objections must be lodged with the Secretary within thirty minutes of the conclusion of the class or event concerned. No objection shall be accepted or considered by the Committee unless lodged before said time. Each objection shall be accompanied by a fee of €30 which will be retained if objection is over-ruled.
17. Each Exhibitor or their agent shall be prepared to certify all statements in his or her Entry Form in any manner the Committee may require.
18. Prize winners may at the discretion of the Judges and/or the Committee be required to subject their animals to a Veterinary examination.
19. All foals must be adequately haltered and led, the Committee reserve the absolute right to have any foal removed from the Show Grounds and to forfeit their entry fee if not properly led and haltered.
20. All entries made by telephone must be followed by correct entry fee.
21. A 'Pass' covers free entry to the show for one person only.
22. 5% on all prize winners in horse, pony, cattle and sheep classes will be deducted from prize winners and forwarded to the I.S.A.
23. Prize money for the Home Industry and Dogs will be paid out on Show Day and will have to be signed for.
24. Ages of Animals to be correctly stated on entry forms.
25. Cattle and Horses must be provided with sufficient halters and caretakers must be in

- attendance at all times during the day.
26. All animals to remain on Show Field until after 4 p.m.
 27. All accidents/incidents to be reported to the Secretary.
 28. Any animal out of box must be attended to.
 29. Only one nomination to be won per Brood Mare, Horse/Pony in any one year.
 30. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be on time for the judging of their class.
 31. Prizes will be paid out on Show Day.
 32. **Intending exhibitors are advised to ensure that their Public Liability Insurance covers the exhibition of their Bloodstock/Livestock at Public Shows.**

are proud to present the following Championships and wishes to acknowledge the generous sponsorships which make these competitions possible. For the efficient running of the Championships all concerned are requested to read and observe the Rules set out below.

General Rules for ISA Championships 2011

A. ELIGIBILITY OF SHOWS

Shows wishing to participate in the 2011 Championships and be eligible to hold qualifiers, must have collected the Championship Fund Levy (currently 5%) from Horse, Pony, Cattle and Sheep Class Prize money for the year 2010 and forwarded the amount so collected, in full, to the Irish Shows Association Head Office within the stipulated period of not more than 30 days from the date of their show. Alternative methods of meeting this obligation are not acceptable.

Any show or competitor in breach of the rules set out below will be disqualified from participating or competing in these championships.

These General Rules and those relating to individual championships (where applicable) should be published in the show schedule and catalogue of the participating shows and must be strictly observed.

B. QUALIFYING ROUNDS (QUALIFIERS)

Qualifying rounds will take place at eligible shows selected by the Irish Shows Association.

C. RESPONSIBILITY OF SHOWS HOLDING QUALIFYING ROUNDS

- a. Selected Shows should hold a separate class for each qualifier from which the highest placed animals will qualify.
- b. The Qualifier class should be held as the first (1st) class in the relevant section of the show.
- c. Shows must ensure that the qualifiers are held strictly in accordance with the relevant rules.
- d. No other sponsor may be involved in qualifying classes.
- e. Shows may charge an entry fee for each qualifying class. **The I.S.A. will award a rosette to the successful qualifiers on appearance at the final.**

- f. **No Show hosting a Championship Final may hold a qualifier for that Championship on the day of the final other than by agreement with the Irish Shows Association.**
- g. Animals qualified for finals are **not** eligible to enter in any other show class at the show where the final is held other than a Qualifying Class for another competition.
- h. Shows **should** appoint competent, well briefed persons to act as Stewards, who must ensure that only animals (or other exhibits) which are eligible to compete and those whose documentation is in order are allowed to proceed to the judging ring.
- i. Animal passports should be read by a Veterinary Surgeon appointed by the show.
- j. On completion of judging, Stewards must instruct the successful competitors to attend at Show Secretary's Office **within one hour** and to complete the necessary documentation for entry to the championship final.
- k. The show must appoint a well-briefed officer, who will be in attendance at the Secretary's Office and who will assist exhibitors to complete the necessary documentation for participation in the final and to collect the relevant entrance fee.
- l. **Show Secretaries must forward complete result cards, together with appropriate fees to the Irish Shows Association within three (3) days following the holding of the show.**
N.B. Shows must return results cards marked "No Competition" for any or all events for which no animal (or exhibit) has been selected.

D. RESPONSIBILITY OF EXHIBITORS

- a. **Exhibitors accept that the Judges decision is final in all cases.** Any abuse of judges will not be tolerated. Where a dispute or case for complaint arises, the matter should only be dealt with under f. below.
- b. **Winners of Qualifiers are themselves responsible for entering their animals (or exhibits) for the final in accordance with j. and k. above, within one hour of qualifying.**
- c. Winners of qualifiers will compete in the final.
- d. The Irish Shows Association in conjunction with the sponsor reserve the right to alter or amend the rules of the competition as may be necessary or appropriate.
- e. **Shows and competitors must contact the I.S.A. for details of any championship and not the sponsor involved.**
- f. **Objections must be lodged in writing with the I.S.A. representative at the show or the Show Secretary within half an hour following the completion of judging,** together with a fee of €50, or other stated fee, which is refundable in the event of the objection being upheld.
- g. Any Exhibitor who makes a false declaration or misrepresents a fact regarding themselves or their exhibit are liable to disqualification and/or forfeiture of any prizes awarded.

E. RESPONSIBILITIES OF SHOWS HOSTING CHAMPIONSHIP FINALS

- a. A deduction of 5% of the prize money is to be collected by the Show and forwarded to the Irish Shows Association within **30 days of the final.**
- b. Championship finals must start **not later than 2 p.m. on the day of the show** and the advertised time of starting **must** be adhered to as far as practicable. If necessary, other show classes should be either postponed or relocated to allow for this.

NOTICES OF INTEREST TO CHAMPIONSHIP PARTICIPANTS **IRISH LAW (EU DIRECTIVE)**

Under Irish Law all horses moving from one location to another must be accompanied by their passports. It is in your own interest to ensure this is the case. Failure to do so

is an offence under Irish Law and is liable on summary conviction to result in a fine up to €3,000.

All passports must be registered with the name of the current owner.

- **Embryo Transfer:** Where a foal is produced by this method the dam's passport must bear a declaration dated, stamped and signed by the stallion owner (or accredited practitioner where AI is involved) stating the date on which the dam was last covered (or inseminated) and the name of the covering stallion.
- The owners of Champions and Reserve Champions are invited to submit the animals' passports to the I.S.A. head office where the placing will be endorsed and officially stamped with the seal of the Irish Shows Association as a permanent record.
- It is in the interest of Shows hosting Championship Finals that photographs and results are forwarded to the Irish Farmers Journal immediately following Judging.

Important Notice to Animal Owners **involved in Showing Animals at Shows**

The Irish Shows Association would advise all Animal Owners who have their Animals Insured to have the **Insurance Cover** extended to cover them while showing animals at Shows. We understand that it costs very little or nothing at all depending on who you have Insurance Cover with.

The reason for us giving you this advice is that if your animal were to lash out and injure someone or damage someone's property and it is established that your animal was out of control at the time, you may be held responsible for any injury or damage caused, and could end up paying all or part of any settlement reached.
